National Seminar on “Internet of Things (IoT)”

Patil Institute of Master of Computer Applications has organized two days National Level Seminar on “Internet of Things (IoT)- Technology of Future” on 30th and 31st January 2018 in association with Savitribai Phule Pune University and seminar was coordinated by Dr. Kavita Suryawanshi, Convener of National Seminar on IoT.

The seminar commenced at 9.00 am on 30th January with participants registration. The inauguration ceremony of the seminar started at 9.30 am with lamp lighting and Sarswati Vandana. After the felicitation of the Chief guest and Guest of honour, welcome address was given by Dr.K. Nirmala, Director DYPIMCA. Dr. Kavita Suryawanshi, Convener briefed participants about the seminar objectives, contents and schedule. Dr. Amol Goje, Guest of Honor interacted with the participants and stated that technology is the integral part of our life. He also advised participants not to use the technology in excess. Dr. R. Venkateswaran briefed participants on Internet of Technology. He also discussed how the combined use of various technologies such as IoT, Machine learning, Big Data Analytics can make our lives better. The first session was started by Mr.Prashant Pansare, CEO, Inteliment Software Technologies Private Solutions. He gave a presentation on how IoT can be used in various areas of our day to day life. Mr.Manish Jain, International Corporate Trainer, in the second session discussed the fundamentals of IoT and various platforms that are used to develop IoT applications. After the lunch break, in session three, Mr.Manish Jain explained the usage of Cloud Computing in developing IoT applications. He demonstrated the cloud-based IoT with examples. The session four of day one was based on the concept of IoT and its security. Dr. Parikshit Mahale, Professor and HOD of Computer Engineering, Smt.Kashibai Navale College of Engineering, Pune, delivered a session on Identity Management in IoT and its security.



Day Two of the seminar started with the session of Mr. Manish Jain and Mr. Akhilesh Chaousara. This was a project based session where projects based on “Interaction with sensors” were developed by the participants. The speakers gave the hands-on practice on how to configure hardware, how to program it with Arduino platforms. After the lunch break Mr. Sushil Kumar Jain guided the participants on developing projects based on the interaction of Arduino with smartphone. Mr. Sajid D Elaskar, Principal Consultant, Cisco System India Limited, delivered a session on IoT and related security. He also explained the concept of Blockchain. The day concluded with the Vote of Thanks by Dr. Kavita Suryawanshi, Convener of the National Level Seminar.
