Interpretations-

Alumni rated the curriculum of other universities higher than that of SPPU curriculum. Alumni noted that other state universities provide dual specialization for MBA program within 2 years of duration. Whereas it takes on more year to pursue second specialization after completion of 2 years of MBA. They suggested that dual specialization should be offered within 2 years duration. It was also suggested that online examination conducted by SPPU should not be conducted because many students not only from our institute but from other institutes also failed in the same even after well preparedness.




Interpretation

However it is also observed that perception of SPPU Syllabus of MCA has proper balance between theory, Practical/Projects is not good (Weighted Avg.=2.65). It was further found through discussion with parent that they are more concern about placement and up gradation of SPPU syllabus. This was communicated to the BOS Chairman. Parent's concern was practical and projects should be given more time and focus. Mini Projects phase wise presentations were conducted for better understanding of programming concepts.


From analysis it was found that Employer perceive that overall perception of employers about SPPU curriculum is good. Some employers, however suggested that Institute should encourage students to undertake live projects from Industry and Syllabus should be flexible to incorporate such project works in academics while the classroom sessions are being conducted. According to employers current curriculum has provision for Summer Internship Projects and Dissertation Projects, however students may not learn the actual working processes and practices only within the stipulated time (8weeks). Minimum six months should be allotted for field works/ Internships/ live projects to gain better understanding of processes and practices.


Interpretation:
