Minutes of IQAC Meeting held on 21 July 2021 at Board Room

Dr. K. Nirmala (Director) welcomed all members. Following point was discussed during the meeting.

1. Virtual Internships for MBA Students

Summer Internships allow students to get real-world work experience which is a first step towards a successful career. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, it was not possible for the students to physically visit the industry and take up summer internships. It was suggested that a proposal should be sent to the industry to facilitate virtual internships for students thereby allowing them to experience work virtually.

2. Desk Research

It was further suggested that there should be provision for students to carry out research amid the Covid-19 pandemic. Desk research should enable the students to conduct research without actually visiting the industry. This could be achieved with the help from industries and academia. Students should be provided online support in their efforts to carry out research. Various resources and tools for research should be provided virtually.

3. Planning of Academic Roadmap for Commencement of Offline Teaching and Learning Sessions

As the impact of pandemic was reducing, Dr. Nirmala came up with the suggestion that the institute should now prepare a roadmap wherein detailed plan about how to commence with offline teaching and learning should be worked out. She also insisted that there should be complete adherence to all the strict safety protocols issued by the government. This will help to assure parents regarding the safety precautions being taken in the campus and instill confidence in the minds of students to resume with offline mode of education.
